What You Can Grow

With hydroponics, you can successfully grow more than 140 different crop varieties. From seed to harvest, it takes between 5 and 12 weeks depending on the crop and accounting for trim (partial) harvests.

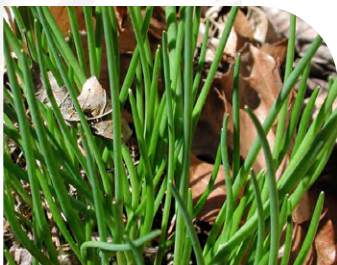

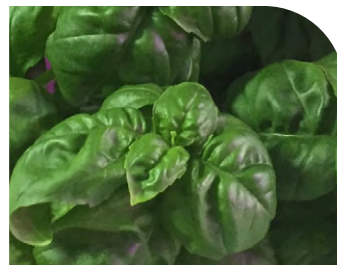

We recommend you start with 5 to 6 main crops to become comfortable with your farm in the first year. Growcer's training helps optimize your planting schedules and overall production.

Current customers grow wildfire lettuce, arugula, Monte Carlo romaine, spinach, kale, bok choy, mint, basil, cilantro, and mountain sorrel (qungulit).
